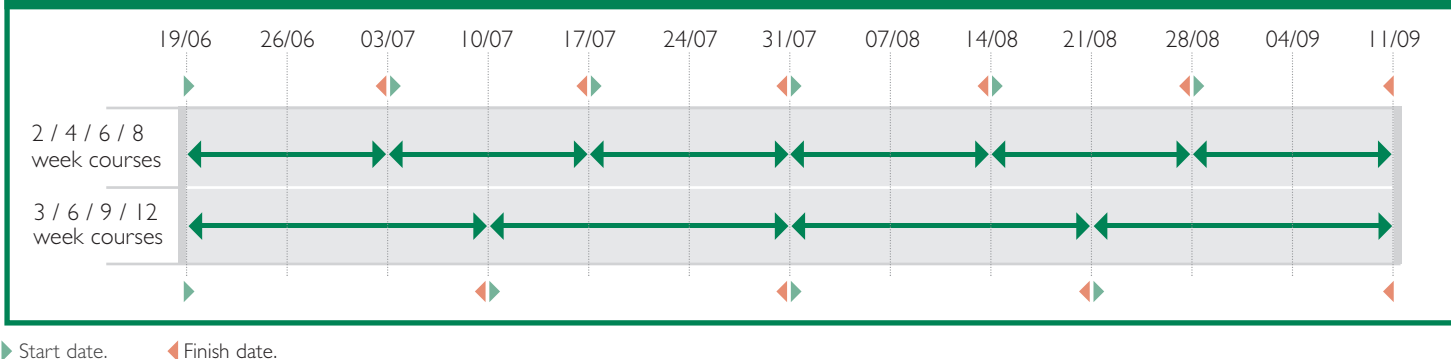

Transfer Service

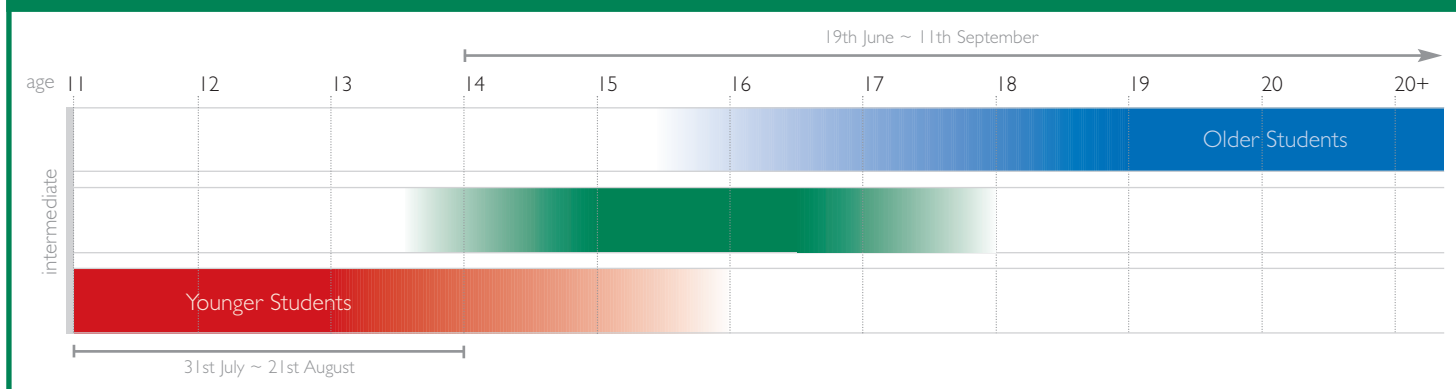
All courses start on a Sunday. For students under the age of 18 at the start of their course, we include a free transfer service. Summer Course students are divided by age and by ability. You will be tested on your first day and will be placed in an appropriate level. We run classes from elementary to advanced.

The minimum age on the Summer Course is 14. However, for the first 3 weeks in August we also accept students aged 11 ~ 13 and provide additional classes. This allows younger students

to experience a serious language course. The course is academic in nature and will not suit all youngsters. Parents should contact the College before booking if they have any concerns.
