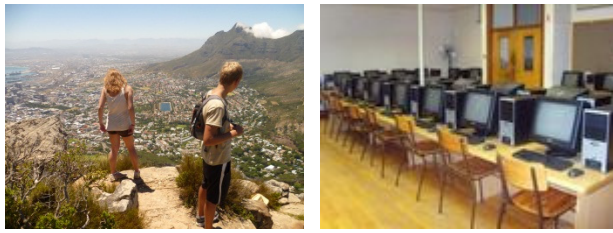
## Tableview High School
