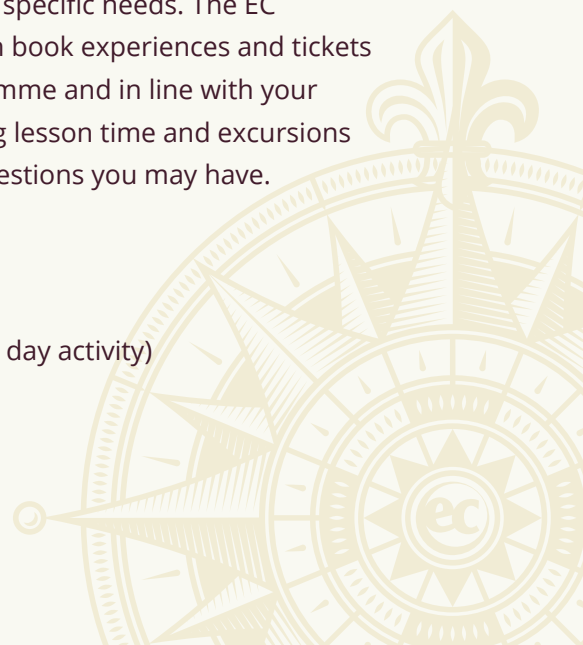

Statue of Liberty, Food Tour & New York's Best Parks

This experience includes round-trip ferry access to the Statue of Liberty grounds on Liberty Island, a visit to the new Statue of Liberty Museum, and the Ellis Island Immigration Museum. Additionally, explore the interior of the Statue of Liberty's pedestal for an up-close look at this iconic monument.

- Little Island: A new public park offering a blend of nature and art in an urban oasis on the Hudson River.
- High Line: A 1.45-mile elevated linear park, greenway, and rail trail, repurposed from a former New York Central Railroad spur.
- Hudson Yards: Hudson Yards has become the cultural center of Manhattan's New West Side. A template for the future of cities, this new neighborhood has not only changed the way New York looks to the world, but the way the world sees New York.

Brooklyn Street Art Walking Tour



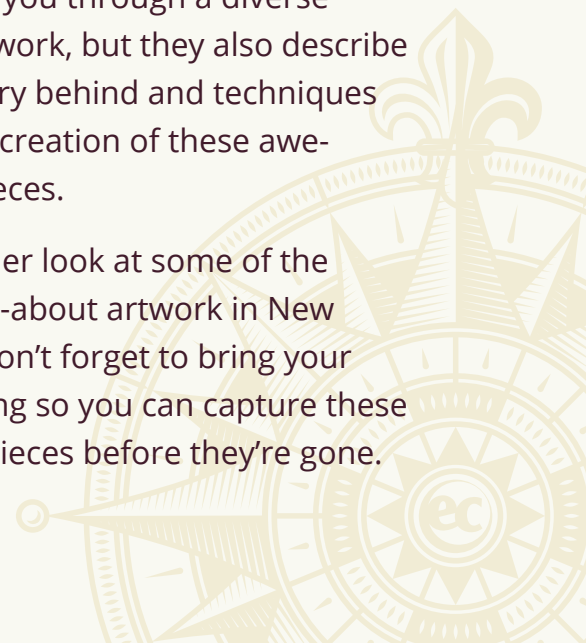
Take a walking tour of the Bushwick Brooklyn Neighborhood to discover the history of urban culture in these vibrant New York City neighbourhoods. Bushwick is world famous for hosting the best street art in the United States. Our tours take you through the streets and show you dozens of these vibrant murals and teach about the artists and their process. Led by a local artist, you gain insight into the graffiti culture and discover amazing murals and spontaneous pieces along the way.

The massive warehouses that line the streets of this neighborhood provide a perfect canvas for this diverse array of vibrant masterpieces, including works by Nick Walker, BK Foxx, Calicho, Jeff Henriquez, Yok and Sheryo, and more. Your tour ticket helps fund the murals which you see on the tour.

Your tour guides will have an intimate knowledge of the street art and graffiti world and may even show you some of their own art during the journey! On this educational tour, you gain a fuller understanding of the difference between tagging, graffiti, and street art.
