

Midtown 525

Description of Local Area

Located on Lexington Ave. and East 48th and 49th Street, this residence is used exclusively by students from the USA and around the world. Conveniently located a mile from Grand Central Station and the iconic Chrysler Building, Students can also enjoy the many shops, restaurants, café's and bars on 3rd and 2nd Avenues, a 5-minute walk away.

Description of Accommodation

Midtown 525 is a student residence with tons of amenity spaces, including study areas, gym, laundry, and more!

Each student is given 1 blanket, 1 top sheet, 1 fitted sheet, 1 pillow/pillowcase, 1 basic towel (20″ x 35″), 1 plate, 1 cup, 1 bowl, and 1 set of cutlery. Each room is also supplied with 1 roll of toilet paper. **Should students need additional items, they are required to provide their own.**

There are two types of rooms at Midtown 525:

Standard: A single room furnished with two twin-size beds, closet, desk, and chair. The room includes a refrigerator, microwave and an ensuite bathroom.

Twin: A double (two-person) shared room. The room is furnished with two twin-size beds, a closet, and two desks and chairs. The room includes a refrigerator, microwave and an ensuite bathroom.


Miscellaneous

- Cleaning is provided in between checkouts. Additional room cleaning and linen cleaning can be provided at \$75/clean.
- App operated laundry room 2.50/wash & 2.50/dry
- Students may rent cooking utensils and cookware from the school for \$10 plus a \$40 refundable cash deposit.
- 24-Hour Security on-site.
- Utility bills included.





Journey to school

MTA – 8 min down the M50 bus from East 49th to West 49th, and walk. Or 20 min walk from building.



Arrival and departure

Arrival Day: Saturday (Sunday arrival possible)

Check-in time: 4pm

Early check-in is not allowed.

Arrival Procedures

Check in at front desk for building access and Residence ID Card. To check in you will need your photo id and a copy of your EC English booking confirmation.

Departure Day: Saturday

Check-out time: 10am (no late checkout).
Students must return their Residence ID
Card in the fully filled-out checkout
envelope. Students will drop this envelope
off in the express check-out box. Student
can leave all the linens on the bed, and
make sure all kitchen items are clean.
Please turn off all lights!

Cancellations House Rules

Cancellation prior to arrival

Students cancelling or postponing 14 days or less prior to their accommodation dates will be charged a two-week accommodation fee at the rate quoted in the price list for the accommodation booked and the accommodation placement fee.

Cancellation after arrival

Students leaving their accommodation must give notice in writing 4 weeks prior to termination. If the 4-week notice period is not provided a cancellation fee equal to 4 weeks of the accommodation cost will apply. After deducting the price of accommodation used at the rate quoted in the price list, including the required notice period charged at the same rate, students will be refunded the remaining accommodation costs.

Airport Pickup

If you booked an airport transfer, after you collect your luggage and exit into the Arrivals Area, find the Welcome Center and look for your driver. Your driver will be waiting there with a sign that has your name on it.

NOTE: International transfers will arrive one hour after the flight lands and domestic arrivals will arrive 30 minutes after the flight lands to allow the students to retrieve their luggage. If you do not see a driver with a sign with your name on it, please call the EC New York Emergency phone line at +1-631-612-4494.

- Students need to be 18 years old to use this accommodation
 - The building is mixed gender.
 - The property is 100% smoke-free, including vapes and e-cigarettes.
 - No pets or partying.
 - Guests under 18 years old are not permitted. To host a guest, students must obtain the permission of their roommate as applicable for each occasion. All guests must provide proof of vaccination against COVID-19. For guest arrangements, students are required to submit guests request through their StarRez portal at least one hour before the reservation time. Please note that guests are not provided with linens or door cards.
 - Students arriving in EC accommodation between 22.00 08.00 may be asked to book alternative accommodation for their first night. This is to ensure student's safety on arrival.
 - While we promote and support diversity, we cannot guarantee language mix. However, we always encourage students to use English to communicate, be respectful and inclusive of others.
 - EC provides a clean living space for all students and expects a basic level of respect from all students. For example, if something is dropped, pick it up; do not leave clothes and belongings on the floor; place rubbish and leftovers in a garbage bag.
 - Students are required to follow **EC Student Code of Conduct**, failure to do so can result in termination of the accommodation.
